The High School Placement Test, called HSPT for short, is divided into five parts and takes approximately 2 hours and 30 minutes. Each question offers three or four choices, labeled (A), (B), (C), (D), and students are not penalized for answering incorrectly.

The Scholastic Testing Service converts the raw scores to standard scores that are reported on a scale of 200 to 800. Percentile rankings are also determined at that time, and distributed to schools.

Some schools may ask students to take an additional test in Catholic Religion, Mechanical Aptitude, or Science; however any score on this optional part is not included in the total score on the exam.

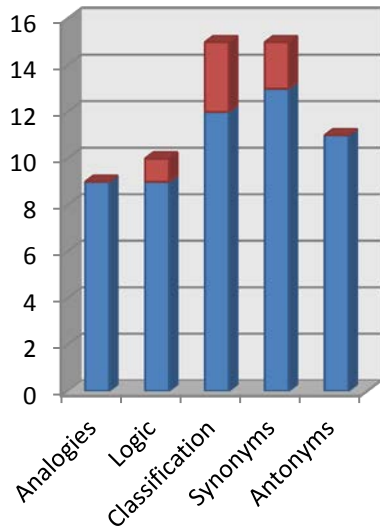

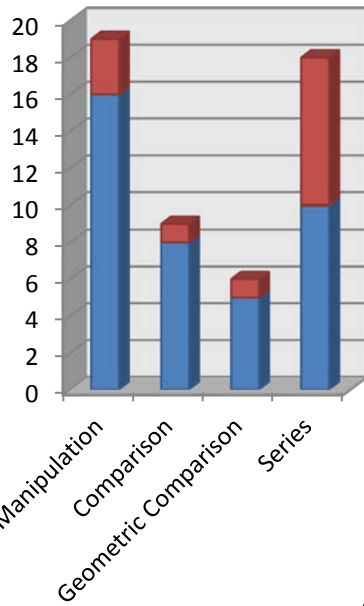

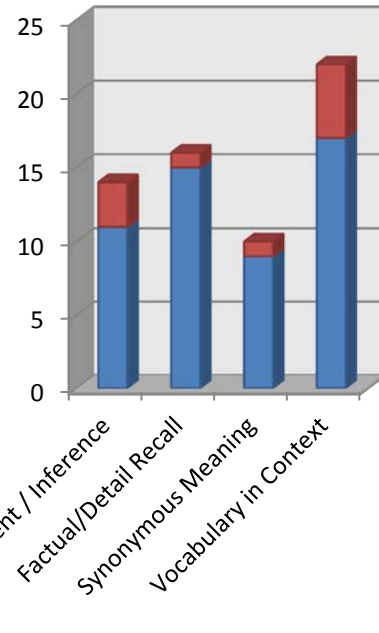

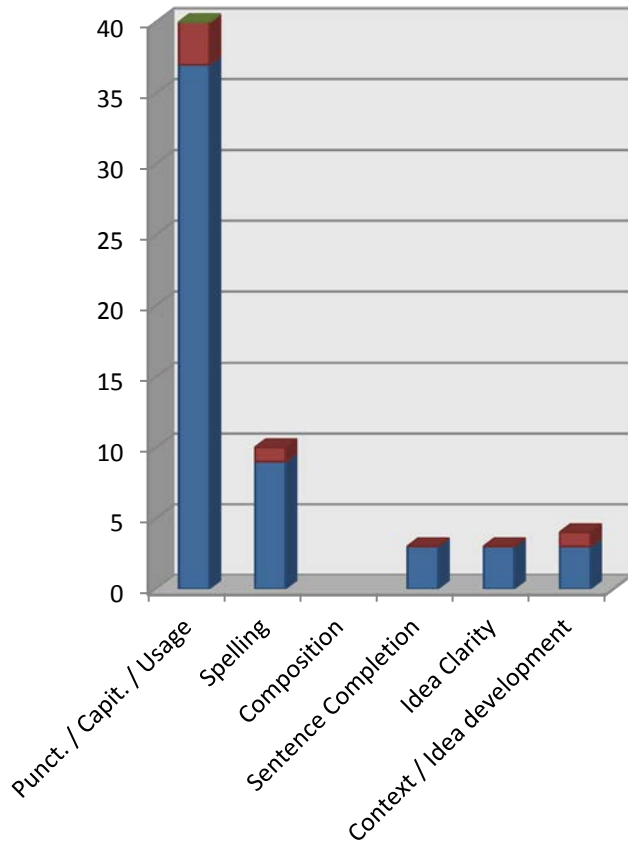

Category Breakdown

Verbal Skills

Analogies

Verbal analogy questions test your ability to see a relationship between words and apply that relationship to other words.

Logic

Logic questions take a slightly different form than other questions on the exam. In these questions, you are given a series of

Classification

Verbal classification questions provide you with four words. Three of these words will have a characteristic or theme in common,

Synonyms

Synonym questions test the depth of your vocabulary and understanding of words. You are asked to choose another word that has

Antonyms

Antonym questions also test your understand of words. However, your task is to define the indicated word and pick its opposite.

Quantitative Skills

Number Manipulation

Number Manipulation questions test your ability to change words into mathematical operations and solve the resulting equation.

Comparisons

Non-geometric comparison questions provide you with three statements. You are asked to perform all of the operations, and then

Geometric Comparisons

Geometric comparison questions will provide you with a geometric figure that you must study and analyze. With that information,

Series

Series questions test your ability to reason without words. Here you must first identify the relationship between a series of symbols,

Reading Comprehension

Author's Intent / Inference

Inference questions require you to read "between the lines" and deduce the author's tone or intent.

Factual / Detail Recall

Facutal recall questions test your ability to recall written details from the passage.

Synonymous Meaning

Synonymous meaning questions test your ability to define words in the context of the passage. If an exact match does not exist, you

Vocabulary in Context

Vocabulary questions will provide you with an underlined vocabulary word with a couple of additional words for context. You are

Mathematics

Problem Solving

Here you will find a variety of problems, ranging from world problems to simple arithmetic options, where you must use logic and

Concepts

These questions test your knowledge of mathematical concepts and are broken down into the following sub-categories:

- Fractions / Decimals

- Unit / Conversions

- Numbers

- Algebra (e.g. variables, equations, number sets)

- Geometry (e.g. area, perimeter, degrees)

Language

Punctuation / Capitalization / Usage

These questions test your general grammar knowledge. You are asked to look for errors in the first three answer choices (A), (B), or

Spelling

Spelling questions ask you to identify the answer choice with a spelling mistake

Composition

These questions are designed to test your ability to properly compose a sentence or phrase within a larger context, and are broken

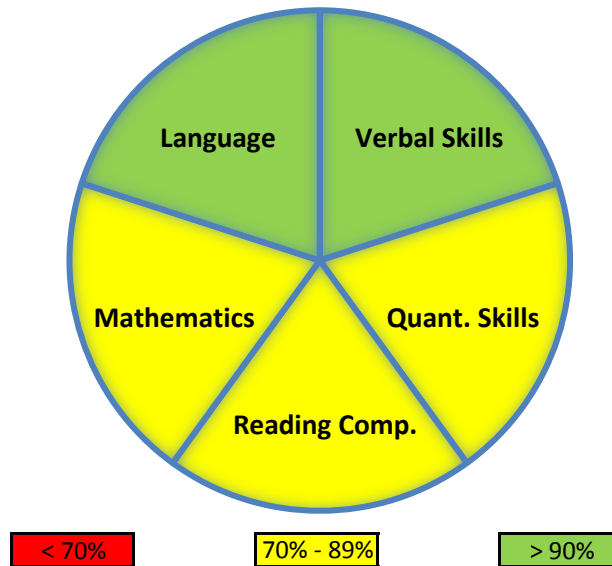
- Sentence Completion - You must use context clues to determine the best word/phrase to complete the sentence.

- Idea Clarity - You must choose the answer choice which most clearly states its meaning.

- Context / Idea Development - You may have to place a sentence in the correct position, identify the odd sentence, or

Score Analysis - At a Glance

Here is a simple visual breakdown of each of the five major sections. Each color denotes a percentage range noted



The HSPT contains 298 multiple-choice questions and is divided up into five sections: Verbal Skills, Quantitative Skills, Reading Comprehension, Mathematics, and Language.

Verbal Skills

This section includes synonyms, antonyms, analogies, logic, and verbal classifications. All five questions will be mixed together in no particular order.

Quantitative Skills

This section focuses on your ability to work with number manipulation, non-geometric comparisons, geometric comparison, and series.

Reading Comprehension

This section attempts to judge how well you comprehend what you read and your ability to infer vocabulary meaning. This section is split into two parts: reading comprehension and vocabulary in context.

Mathematics

Mathematics includes mathematical concepts and problem solving drawn from arithmetic, elementary algebra, and basic geometry. This section is split into two parts: concepts, and problem solving.

Language

Language skills questions test your understanding of writing mechanics, capitalization, usage, spelling, expression, and sentence order. This section is split into three parts: punctuation/capitalization/grammar, spelling, and composition.
