## Interpreting your score report

The Reading \& Writing Score is made up of the Reading Section and the Writing \& Language Section. The Math Score is made up of both Math Sections, with and without a calculator. As in a non-practice SAT a raw score is generated first, and then a scaled score is produced on the 400-1600 scale. The scaling process ensures that the final score is comparable across other test forms.

Please note that you will receive a minimum score of 200 in either Enhanced Reading and Writing, or Math, if you do not answer any of the questions in the related sections.

The raw score is calculated by adding 1 point for each question answered correctly. The Composite score is simply the sum of your two scaled scores.

If you opted to take the essay, your essay is graded on a scale of 2-8 in each of the dimensions of Reading, Analysis \& Writing. The maximum essay score is 24.

In the Your Answer column you will see one of the following: a + indicates that you answered the question correctly; a letter A-D indicates your incorrect answer (the correct answer is in the column to the left); a dash represents an omitted question. You can quickly identify your incorrect answers and how they are clustered on the exam, because the section and number are highlighted in red. Questions left blank are highlighted in light blue. The SAT has no penalty for incorrect answers, so you should not leave questions blank even if it means having to randomly fill in bubbles as time runs out.

The Item Type analyses allow you to see your relative performance in the different question subjects and types. The Raw Score at the top of each page (pages 3-6) gives you your raw score for that section. The \% of column is your raw points divided by the total raw points possible on those questions. For example, if you achieved 9 raw points on the 15 questions about Heart of Algebra questions, then your \% would be $9 / 15$ or $60 \%$.
